President's Report January 19, 2021

Branch Campus

Scott and I have met with staff from both Valencia and Taos. Both of these campuses have staff organizations; and I believe we members of both in attendance as guests today. These branch campuses are interested in deepening their relationships with Staff Council and also with each other; and I am continuing to explore those options. In general, upper leadership supports branch staff being able, minimally, to vote in Staff Council elections; and I support that idea. We have not yet made much headway with either the Los Alamos or Gallup branches, neither of which have existing staff associations to my knowledge.

UNM Budget

Since our last Business Meeting, the Budget Leadership Team considered and largely approved the use of Student Funds recommended by the Student Fee Review Board, which is comprised of students. They did an admirable job. BLT amended their proposal in two ways – one, to deny funding towards some lab equipment that did not seem to have a student benefit; and two, to put those funds towards Athletics instead. BLT has heard concerns from Athletics about the Student Fee application process – namely that the size and complexity of the Athletics budget and the turnover in Review Board members and the Board's priorities means that Athletics Department if left feeling uncertain about funding and frustrated with differences in how to present their proposal every year. Eddie Nunez has requested to remove Athletics from the process; that has not yet been determined.

BLT has also been focused on ways to simplify tuition and fees. Group considered small and incremental increases in tuition to be preferable over large and infrequent increases. Dan Garcia provided some scenarios based on proposed tuition increases and simplified fees which appear not too damaging—though one area of concern is high amount of debt and higher interest rate for graduate students. One good thing for staff is the elimination of the by-course online fee with flat (higher) technology fee, which our IT Subcommitte worked to have covered by Tuition Remission. EVP Costantinitis reviewed with us University borrowing and debt practices.

BLT's proposal to President Stokes is due April 1st. Now there is one ad-hoc committee; and I have requested a second regarding compensation and benefits; that is under consideration. The NM Executive Budget proposal does not include a raise in compensation; the Legislative Branch recommendation does, and we think it is based on the new funding formula established last year that includes a higher percentage of staff; but UNM Government Relations is confirming that. Regarding the faculty union – the union will have to abide by what the Legislature passes.

As an aside, the need for the community to be educated about budget affairs that I've mentioned before may be addressed during Professional Development Day(s); and Provost Holloway offered that he and EVP Teresa Costantinitis might be the presenters.

The Capital Project Leadership Team has not met since we last met; next meeting is tomorrow.

LoboCard Initiative

Tricky problem with not all (perhaps most) HSC ID badges not being Lobo-Encoded. Solutions are in process but may be clunky and not immediate.

Human Resources

HR released information about the time extension to E-PSL program.

Ms. Anderson is working with DOH to make sure vaccination priorities are properly assigned to UNM employees.

HR is piloting a program to provide a monthly stipend to certified bilingual staff in HR who use their skills on the job; and this might be offered as an advertised option to Departments if successful.

International Staff

- 1. Listserv for international employees After some initial jockeying, the Division of Human Resources has now taken on the project of establishing a single listserv for international staff and faculty.
- 2. Tuition remission is still being explored by FSBC; and Scott may have an update for us in his report.

Divesting from Fossil Fuels

Three people from the UNM Coalition on Climate (staff, faculty, students) presented to large number of UNM leadership, including members of the Foundation, regarding the necessity of addressing climate change and fiscal responsibility of divestment. Faculty Senate has a resolution in process (not yet passed?) that discusses divestment and other drawdown (of greenhouse gases) strategies that are quite complimentary IMO. I feel this is in Administration's hands for the moment.

Odds and Ends

- I would like to request the 3 or 4 councilors who attended the LEAN training sponsored by the Policy Office to report out its usefulness to Staff Council at their convenience.
- Members of SC DEI and I met with HSC DEI to discuss possible areas of collaboration, including especially around
 common goals of hiring and advancing a diverse workforce and intentional examination of policies and practices with
 diversity in mind. In addition, HSC DEI has a strong focus on events; I invited them to collaborate with the SC HSCS
 committee if they need volunteers.
- Some priorities in leadership from the end of November (last Executive Cabinet meeting): Keeping good numbers COVID-wise, Student engagement & mental health, closing/restricting public spaces, protecting faculty from student evaluations during COVID, bed utilization at UNMH, projected losses in enrollment for Spring (esp. branch campuses), low faculty salaries in comparison to peer institutions.
- 94 staff retirees by end of January, showing impact of the voluntary retirement program.
- Regents whose terms have ended/ are ending: Doughty, Lee, and Henry. If you have questions about Regent sub-committee meetings after reading what I sent in December to all staff, please let me know.
