It is PATS position that they can be easily accommodated with the supervisor/ADA van. There is infrequent and inconsistent usage of wheelchair ramp buses on North Campus. People can schedule accessible buses or call/wait for supervisor. Recommendation: Reach out to ARC for lived experience advice/communication recommendations. Low use does not mean low impact.
