

IMPORTANT UNM RECYCLING INFO UNM Recycling would like to clarify some of our processes. Recycling techs will not enter

offices to pick up blue desk side bins, these bins must be emptied by the office occupant into the larger blue bins located on their floor.

Also cardboard boxes should not be left in hallways. UNM Safety and Risk Services has determined that neither corridors nor exits may be blocked by furniture or other obstructions since it could slow evacuation in the event of an emergency. Neither custodians nor recycling techs are allowed to remove cardboard boxes from the hallways, this is the responsibility of the building occupants. Cardboard boxes should be flattened and placed adjacent to the large blue recycling bins, inside a trash room, or in the cardboard cages located outside near the building loading dock.
