### **COVID-19 Vaccine Registration Update**

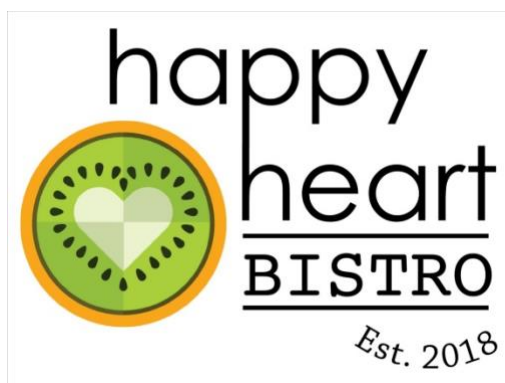

As the New Mexico Department of Health prepares to move our state on to Phase 1b, we are happy to announce that as of Saturday, Jan. 9, all UNMH vaccine scheduling will now be through the [NM DOH vaccination website](#)! This means that anyone who hasn't yet received the vaccine (including providers and staff in our UNM and Health System community), and who wants to receive a vaccination, should register for their vaccination through the [NM DOH vaccination website](#).
