3	Guest: Staff Council President Ryan Gregg addressed UNM Medical Plan and other questions.	Acknowledged that questions about medical plan are consistently brought up at Town Hall meetings. Employees who move to higher salary tier often get lower take home pay due to increase in health insurance payments deducted from paychecks. Explained the three (3) salary tiers. State statute regulates how much UNM pays so cannot increase. To change it would make us pay more due to state regulation limits. Employees have to advocate to themselves to get increase so they do not take less take home pay after reaching the next tier. Finance and HR working on adjustment so employee does not have to advocate for themselves. Unfortunately, not able to do this for union employees. HR working on a compensation study on how to address inequities.
